



Volunteer Care Package Delivery Driver

The role

As a Volunteer Care Package Delivery Driver, you will assist the Golden Oldies team by delivering Care Packages to our members within the Southwark borough. The care packages will include hot meals, fruit and may also include but not limited to other donated items including toiletries, arts and crafts and other food items.

Role Responsibilities

As a Care Package Delivery Driver, you will be required to follow the below responsibilities:

- To attend a designated pick-up location within Southwark to collect and pack care packages.
- To deliver care packages to members mainly in Southwark except for two in the Lewisham Borough
- To follow COVID-19 safety guidelines during the collection and delivery of meals including wearing provided PPE.
- To maintain communication with the Care-Coordinator
- As this is a lunch time delivery service, we require all drivers to be punctual and be on shift on time to ensure lunches are being delivered with the lunch delivery slot
- On occasions, to pick up additional items which have been donated to members from Southwark based organisations.
- Be professional and respectful to Golden Oldies members and staff.
- To follow confidentiality guidelines

Skills or experience that would be helpful

The Volunteer Care Package Delivery Driver would have the following skills and experience:

- Employment in supporting older people (preferred)
- Experience of delivering goods (preferred)
- Valid driving licence (essential)
- Car owner, or access to a car during volunteer hours (essential)
- To be punctual, reliable and adaptable (essential)

How will you be supported?

- Thorough induction into the Association and the role
- On-going support from the staff
- Reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses
- Volunteer discount cards
- Hot nutritious meal

- Access to a range of workshops, training and events

Time/Commitment

- 2-4 hours a week
- Tuesday and or Thursday
- 12:00-14:00
- Minimum commitment 3 months

Care Package deliveries take between 1-2 hours to complete and are delivered to our members every Tuesday and Thursday from 12:00, your role will require you to be at the pickup location by 12:00
